

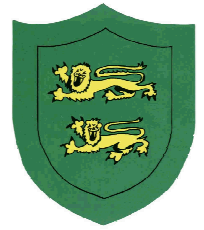

MEMBERSHIP REPORT - 03 October 2007

The current total membership is down 3 from the last report at 917, including 4 complimentary memberships. There have been 11 joiners and 14 leavers in the period (list attached). Of the 11 complimentary members included in the last report, 4 have upgraded to full membership, while 3 have lapsed, leaving 4 remaining.

Personal Membership (ie excluding corporate schemes) stands at 89 and there are 828 corporate members, almost identical to the figures for one year ago.

If the RIB membership is excluded, the percentage of non-entitled members stands at 12.3%, which allows us to add a maximum of 12 non-entitled members and stay within the 15% limit.
